

Marriage (Amendment) Regulations, 2018 (No. 10)

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Justice, Legal and Parliamentary Affairs has, in terms of section 36(1)(d) of the Marriage Act [*Chapter 5:11*], approved the following regulations made by the Registrar of Marriages:—

1. These regulations may be cited as Marriage (Amendment) Regulations, 2018 (No. 10).

2. Section 14 of the Marriage Regulations, 1979, published in Statutory Instrument 866 of 1979, is repealed and substituted by the following—

“Fees

14. The fee payable for—

- (a) non-marriage certificate shall be fifty dollars;
- (b) examinations for marriage officers shall be fifty dollars;
- (c) certificate for marriage officer shall be five dollars;
- (d) authentication of marriage certificate—
 - (i) for locals shall be thirty-five dollars; and
 - (ii) for foreigners or diaspora use shall be seventy-five dollars;
- (e) duplicate marriage certificate shall be ten dollars;
- (f) alteration of marriage certificate shall be ten dollars;
- (g) late submission of marriage register up to 12 months shall be fifty dollars, and for any period after 12 months the officer will be taken to court;
- (h) cancellation of marriage register by marriage officer shall be ten dollars, per copy;
- (i) clearance banns of marriage license certificate shall be twenty dollars;
- (j) letters of confirmation shall be five dollars;

- (k) renewal of registration of marriage officers, annually, shall be five dollars;
- (l) failure to submit register for inspection shall be one hundred dollars;
- (l) failure to produce a requested register by marriage registry shall be five hundred dollars.”.
