

PROCLAMATION

HIS EXCELLENCY THE HONOURABLE EMMERSON DAMBUDZO MNANGAGWA, G.C.Z.M., President of the Zimbabwe and Commander-in-Chief of the Defence Forces of Zimbabwe.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 39(2) of the Electoral act [*Chapter 2:13*], that after the President has been notified in terms of the said section of vacancies in the membership of Parliament, he shall issue a proclamation ordering a new election to fill the vacancies in the same manner, *mutatis mutandis*, as is provided in section 38 of the said Act in regard to a general election;

AND WHEREAS, the Speaker of Parliament has notified me on 24th June, 2019, in writing of a vacancy which has arisen by reason of the death of Hon. Obedingwa Mguni on 18th June, 2019, who was elected member of the National Assembly for Mangwe Constituency:

NOW, THEREFORE, under and by virtue of the powers vested in the President as afore said, I do, by this proclamation—

- (a) order a new election for the constituency of Mangwe; and
- (b) fix Friday the 26th of July 2019, as the date on which the nomination court shall sit, commencing at 10 o'clock in the morning at the Magistrates' Court, Fifth Avenue, Gwanda for the purpose of receiving nomination of candidate for election as a member of the National Assembly Constituency for Mangwe; and
- (c) fix Saturday the 7th of September 2019, as the day on which a poll shall be taken if a poll becomes necessary in terms of section 46(17)(c) of the Electoral Act [*Chapter 2:13*].
