

Public Finance Management (Prescription of Accounting Officers and Receivers of Revenue) (Amendment) Regulations, 2019 (No. 1)

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IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Finance and Economic Development has, in terms of section 92 as read with section 10(1) of the Public Finance Management Act [*Chapter 22:19*], made the following regulations:—

*Title*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Public Finance Management (Prescription of Accounting Officers and Receivers of Revenue) (Amendment) Regulations, 2019 (No. 1).

2. The Public Finance Management (Prescription of Accounting Officers and Receivers of Revenue) Regulations, 2010, published in Statutory Instrument 168 of 2010, are amended by—

(a) the repeal of the First Schedule and substitution of the following—
