

Collective Bargaining Agreement: Salaries and Wages: Tobacco
(Miscellaneous) Sector

IT is hereby notified, that the Minister of Public Service, Labour and Social Welfare has, in terms of section 80(1) of the Labour Act [*Chapter 28:01*], published the Collective Bargaining Agreement as set out in the Schedule, which further amends the agreement published in Statutory Instrument 85 of 1993, which was registered in terms of section 79 of the Labour Act.

Amendment to the Principal Agreement

This further agreement is made and entered into in accordance with the provisions of the Labour Act [*Chapter 28:01*] between the Tobacco (Miscellaneous) Industry Employers' Association (hereinafter referred to as "the employers"), of the one part, and the Zimbabwe Tobacco Industrial Workers' Union (hereinafter referred to as "the employees" or "the trade union"), of the other part, being parties to the National Employment Council for the Tobacco Industry, to amend the Collective Bargaining Agreement (General Conditions of Employment) Tobacco (Miscellaneous) Industry, 1992, published in Statutory Instrument 85 of 1993, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal agreement") shall be read as one with the principal agreement.

Agreement

This further agreement shall be deemed to have come into effect on 1st July, 2019, and is applicable up to 30th September, 2019. Grade minimums have been agreed for the period and are reflected below. In addition, it has been agreed by the Employment Council that the basic wage of an employee is an all inclusive wage, inclusive of all allowances, i.e. housing and transport. In addition, it has been agreed by the Employment Council that this does not preclude employers and employees at Company level Works Council to improve on conditions of service.
