

Public Health (COVID-19 Prevention, Containment and Treatment)
(National Lockdown) (No. 2) (Amendment) Order, 2021 (No. 19)

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Health and Child Care has, in terms of section 8(1) of the Public Health (COVID-19 Prevention, Containment and Treatment) Regulations, 2020 (published in Statutory Instrument 77 of 2020) made the following order—

1. This order may be cited as the Public Health (COVID-19 Prevention, Containment and Treatment) (National Lockdown) (No. 2) (Amendment) Order, 2021 (No. 19).

2. The Public Health (COVID-19 Prevention, Containment and Treatment) (National Lockdown) (No. 2) Order, 2020), published in Statutory Instrument 200 of 2020 (hereinafter called the principal order), is amended by the insertion of the following after section 26B—

“Travellers coming to Zimbabwe from neighbouring countries

26C (1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this order, for the duration of the Easter Holiday, which is to say from 1st April, 2021 to 6th April, 2021, all travellers from neighbouring countries coming into the country must undergo a valid COVID-19 PCR test not more than 48 hours from the time of their departure for Zimbabwe.

(2) A traveller referred to in subsection (1)—

- (a) who does not have a valid PCR test and a certificate to that effect shall be quarantined for 10 days at designated hotels at his or her own expense;
- (b) with proof of a valid PCR negative certificate shall self-quarantine at home or in a hotel at his or her own expense for a period of 10 days from date of arrival into the country.

Tourists to be vaccinated at own cost

26D Tourists who volunteer to be vaccinated can access vaccination services available in Zimbabwe at their own expense.”
