IT is hereby notified that the Collective Bargaining Agreement set out in the Schedule has been registered in terms of section 79 of the Labour Act [Chapter 28:01]:—

SCHEDULE

NATIONAL EMPLOYMENT COUNCIL FOR THE TEXTILE MANUFACTURING INDUSTRY

FURTHER AGREEMENT

This further agreement made and entered into in accordance with the provisions of the Labour Act [Chapter 28:01], as amended, between the Zimbabwe Textile Manufacturers Association (hereafter referred to as "the employer" or the employers organisation"), of the one part, and the Zimbabwe Textile Workers Union (hereafter referred to as "the employee" or "the trade union"), of the other part, being parties to the National Employment Council for the Textile Manufacturing Industry, shall be read as one with the agreement published in Statutory Instrument 147 of 2018, as amended (hereafter referred to as "the principal agreement").

1. Clause 9 of the principal agreement is amended by the deletion of the whole of subclause (3) and the substitution of—

"Clause 9:

The deadlock on wage negotiations in the Textile Manufacturing Industry has now been resolved through voluntary arbitration as agreed by the parties."

Accordingly, the arbitral tribunal awarded that the minimum wage be US\$184,00, with the same percentage differential applying across all grades/levels.

That all companies in the Textile Manufacturing Industry shall pay 45% of minimum wages in United States dollars and the remaining balance of 55% shall be paid in local currency i.e., ZWL, at the prevailing official exchange rate, at the date of processing. For the avoidance of doubt the official exchange rate refers to the RBZ auction rate.

The arbitral tribunal therefore, accordingly dismissed the claim to separate housing and transport allowances from the basic minimum wages.

Having taken into account the facts and evidence given by the parties, the arbitral tribunal awarded that the effective date of implementation of the new minimum wage/salaries be the 1st of February, 2023.

The award shall be applied as follow—
